The facility will be built to withstand a Category 5 hurricane. The existing outdoor Firing Range, K9 and impound areas are to remain active during construction with controlled and monitored access points and perimeters. The construction will be phased to complete the new buildings to facilitate the relocation of operational and K9 areas into the new buildings and then allow those areas to be demolished and the balance of the site work and parking completed.
